Alliance Française–Arnaud Family Scholarship Application Form

This scholarship in French has been given in memory of Phillipe Arnaud by the Alliance Française of Charleston to enable students to study in France. To be eligible for consideration, students must have declared a French major or minor, have sophomore standing or higher, and be a resident of South Carolina. The recipient must be traveling on a semester long program that the College has approved for academic credit, have financial need, and live with a French speaking family. The Alliance Française-Arnaud Family scholarship is available through the department of French, Francophone and Italian Studies. A faculty panel will select the two best candidates and the Alliance Française Scholarship Committee will select the recipient.

Students awarded with this scholarship are required to submit 2 documents at the beginning of the semester following their travel: a budget showing how funds were expended, including an itinerary of the journey, and journal entries highlighting their trip including a testimonial of how scholarship funds impacted their travels.

Applications must be submitted with 2 letters of recommendation.

The scholarship value is \$1,000 and available annually for study in France.
